They also observe festivals and rituals viz. Kurumpandu, Dussera, Kartapandu, Ikkpandu, etc. They live in low thatched houses, cultivating Tobacco leaf, Ragi, Maize, Bhatta paddy, etc. Mahua and Salapa are their ideal drinks. They believe in Puja and use local medicines for their illness and diseases.
